Wash any dishes you used for breakfast and put them away. Turn off all lights, fans. Turn on timer for lights. Unplug all electronics. Water all house plants. Set thermostat for away temperature. Typically 4 degrees from what you normally keep it at. Close blinds and curtains. Be sure your luggage is TSA compliant. (No loose ammunition in your bags!) Double check you have your ID, passport, everything that you need. Some items may include medicine, sunglasses, wallet, phone, phone charger Packing List
